WHAT TO EXPECT - YOUR INTRODUCTION TO NAIL TECHNOLOGY

We would like to take this time to thank you for your interest in the Beginner Nail Technologist Training Program. This program has been designed to provide you with the fundamental skills necessary to enter the beauty industry as a Professional Nail Technician.

Beginner Nail Technologist Training is 24 hours of hands-on practical training. You will be attending four classes at six hours per class; Days 1 and 2 consecutively, a break of two or three weeks to allow for nail growth, then Days 3 and 4 consecutively. **Two models are required for class**; however, one model for Days 1 and 2 can be acceptable. Theory is covered during class time, but the majority of review is home study. The primary focus throughout your program will be form application and sculpting techniques; however, basic tip application will be discussed and reviewed. Hand filing will be taught in Days 1 and 2, with machine filing taught in Days 3 and 4. Please note that it is mandatory for ALL students to complete homework assignments ranging from theory/study to practical application of techniques taught in the class. Success in the course is heavily based on the home work studies, as nail technology is a skill acquired by “hands on” practice.

The exam is a blend of written and practical application, and is scheduled for four hours within six weeks of Day 4. You must achieve an average of 75% to successfully receive certification in this program.

Your educator, Shelley Howlett, is a Master Nail Technician with nine years of working experience and over seven years of educating experience. She has also competed province wide throughout her career, winning first place in 1999. Shelley will help you realize your potential as a nail technician throughout the program and provide mentorship well into your professional career.

Throughout your training program you will be expected to bring and use your own product and tools. Please be sure to bring your tools that have been supplied in your kit to each class. Shelley will be bringing all student kits and provide them on Day 1 of class. Please be sure all homework assignments are complete so we can stay on time and focus on your technical skills. A brief lunch will be provided sometime in the first half of your day.

Day 1: Chapters 1-6, 10-12, 14, 16

Chapters include: Introduction to Amore International; Your Role as a Professional Nail Technician; Structures of the Nail; Nail Growth & Formation; Diseases and Disorders; Sanitation, Disinfection and Sterilization; Client Consultation; Nail Preparation, Nail Tip Application; Gel Nail Application; Shaping and Filing.

We will be doing the most theory on this day so you may make arrangements for your model to arrive at the lunch break. In the afternoon we will be applying a natural gel overlay on one hand of your model, please ensure your model has some natural nail length. The other hand will be assigned as home study.

Day 2: Chapters 7-9, 13-14, 16 and 19

Chapters include: Benefits of Proper Ventilation, Preventing Other Occupational Hazards, Anatomy, Osteology and Dermatology; Nail Forms; Gel Nail Application; Shaping and Filing; Working with Nail Biters.

Your model should arrive with you or shortly after class starts. After a brief lunch, we will be applying nail forms and a French manicure set to one hand of your model. The other hand will be assigned as home study.

Day 3: Chapters 17, 18

Chapters include: Fills and Repairs; Troubleshooting - When You've Tried Everything.

On this day we will learn a complete natural nail fill, and it will take most of the day. Please ensure your model has a natural overlay on both hands. Your model should arrive with you, as the nail fill will consume a lot of our day.

Day 4: Review questions in each chapter should be completed. Theory will cover each chapter's review questions at the end of the day.

On this day we will learn a complete French manicure fill. We will perform this first, as it will take most of the day, so please ensure your model arrives with you at the start of class.
